Product/process development activities **to move up value chain** and must be performed in NTIC’s approved CoE Provider

Project Criteria

✦ The project must have **strategic impact to the ecosystem** development & value chain in NCER.

✦ The project must be in **accordance with the NTIC framework**.

The project must have **business model** for long term self sustainability

Funding

✦ **Matching grant, 50:50 ratio**, max capped at **RM25,000** per project

✦ **Maximum 1 project to develop per year/company** and to allow the usage of multiple of CoE Provider.

✦ Funding is for the **services & consultancy, including usage of equipment, testing, reliability, failure analysis, R&D&D&C activities** provided by NTIC’s approved CoE.

To ensure **no double dipping** from other agencies (Cradle, MIDA, MRANTI etc) by checking document during claim submission.

Claim Method

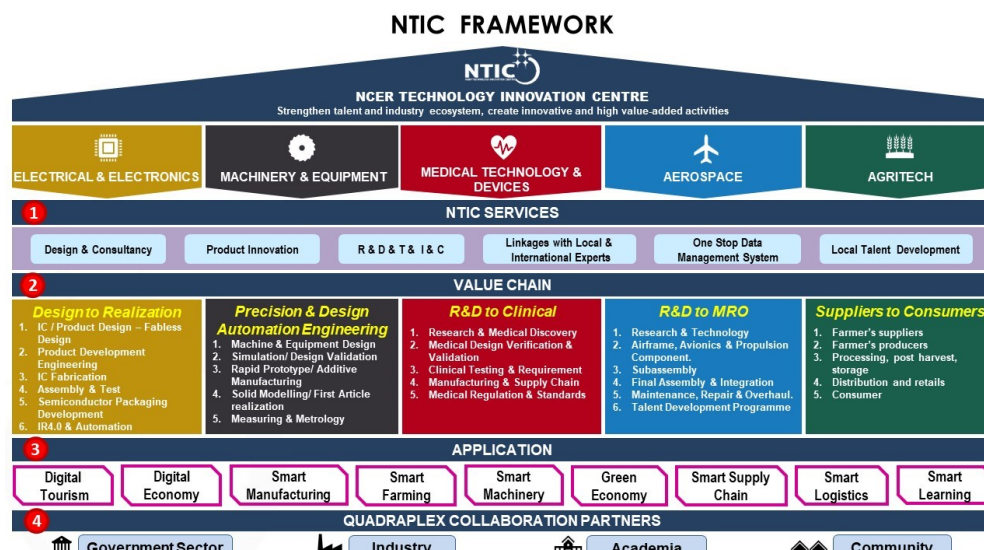
✦ Reimbursement based on invoice, **within 3 months after project completion**.

Project status **verification by appointed industry CoE** for full disbursement upon completion of the service usage.

Agreement

✦ Project duration: **Max of 12 months** from the date of approval.

Agreement period: **Max of 15 months** from the date of approval.
