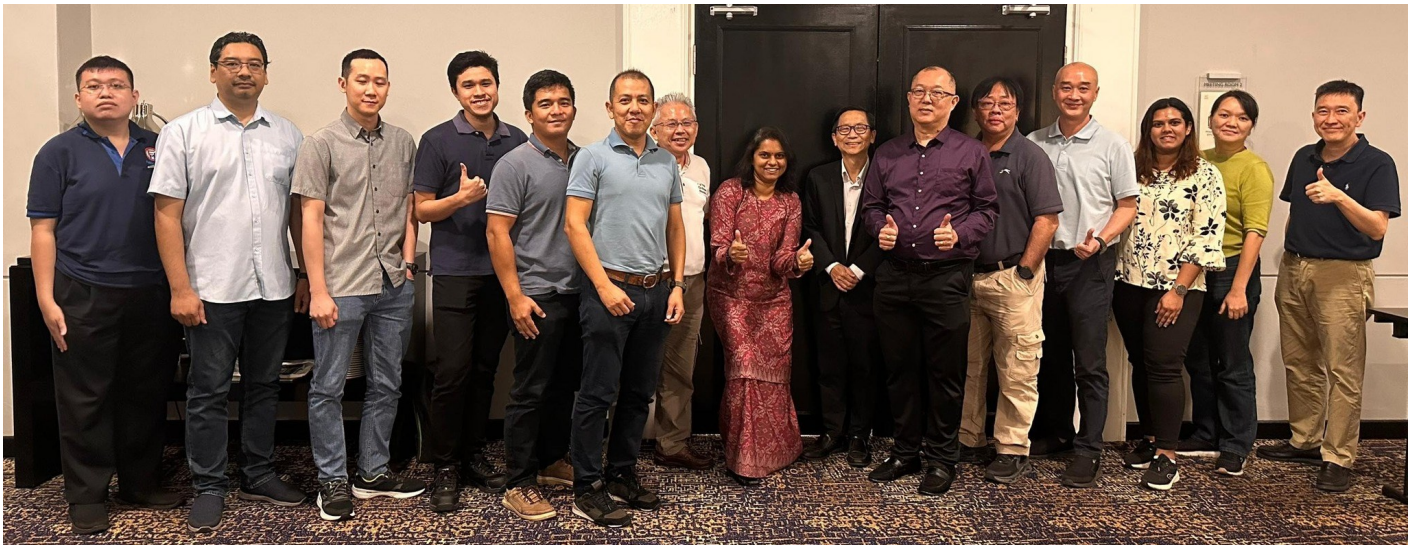

Identifying Material Matters – Using the Framework for Sustainability in Project Management, participants learned how to determine key environmental, social, and governance (ESG) issues relevant to their organization.

SWOT Analysis – A strategic exercise was demonstrated to assess internal strengths and weaknesses while identifying external opportunities and threats in relation to sustainability practices.

Gap Analysis & Sustainability Action Plan – The trainer explained how to evaluate current practices against best standards, identify gaps, and design actionable plans to close those gaps effectively.

Framework Alignment – Guidance was provided on aligning corporate sustainability initiatives with globally recognized standards such as the Global Reporting Initiative (GRI) and the United Nations Global Compact (UNGC) principles, ensuring international compliance and credibility.

Integration Flowchart – A practical flowchart was shared to illustrate how companies can systematically integrate sustainability into their operations across the three core pillars: People, Planet, and Economic Impact.
